The Havasu Landing Resort and Casino along with the Chemehuevi Indian Tribe will unveil a new Chemehuevi Cultural Exhibit at the Ferry Terminal. located in Lake Havasu City, beginning Thursday, November 6. The terminal is currently open for daily ferry boat ticketing and will now offer the story of tribal history and culture.

Six large panels for this colorful and interesting museum-style exhibition are mounted on the interior walls of the tribe's ferryboat terminal at 70 West London Bridge Road. Each describes an aspect of our lifeways, including history, culture, language, transition after Lake Havasu, and contemporary life. In addition are eight framed, dry-mounted plants the Chemehuevis have traditionally used for food, clothing and shelter.

The exhibit, along with the terminal building, will be open 7 days a week from 10:30 am to 6:00 pm. The exhibit is located just north of the London Bridge at 70 London Bridge Rd in Lake Havasu City AZ. 86403. It is also accesible on foot along the Shoreline Trail of the bridge channel.

A grand opening of the show is planned for 6:00 p.m. Arizona time on Wednesday, November 12. Along with the leadership of the tribe, the curator and project consultants will be there to answer questions and share more information.
