GED/HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE, INCENTIVE AWARD, POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

GED/High School Graduate Incentive Award shall be administered, due to the following policy:

Section 1- Funding Limitation

As a graduate incentive to tribal members residing on the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation: the Chemehuevi Indian Tribe will purchase an educational device with the capabilities equivalent to a computer, or provide a monetary award. CIT will purchase the device through the Education Department spending up to \$800.00 per High School Graduate, or up to \$399.00 per GED recipient. The High School Graduate may choose to receive a monetary award in lieu of an educational device, and may receive \$500. *All said awards are depending on availability of funds.*

Section 2- GED/High School Graduate Incentive Award Categories

- A. Graduate from High School or Boarding School while maintaining permanent residency on the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation
- B. Receive GED while residing on the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation

Section 3- Eligibility Requirements

- A. Be an enrolled Chemehuevi Indian Tribal member.
- B. Be a resident of Havasu Lake, California (**Proof of residency will include two documents:** Rent/lease agreement, utility bills, vehicle registration, valid driver's license or state ID, income taxes for self or parent)
- C. Be an applicant in one category designated in Section 2
- D. Provide an **Official Copy of High School Diploma or GED** to the Chemehuevi Education Center, within 90 days of High School Graduation or completion of GED.

Section 4 - Applicant Responsibility

- A. Copy of **Official High School Diploma or GED**, sent by the applicant to the CIT Education Department.
- B. **Proof of residency**, sent by the applicant to the CIT Education Department.
- C. **Proof of Chemehuevi Tribal Enrollment**, sent by the applicant to the CIT Education Department.
