Rules and Regulations

The following are the considered offenses in which the Community Center staff and participants must abide by. Breaking of any offense will be dealt with as outlined in **Community Center Policy and procedure 11.0 Disciplinary and Corrective Action.**

In order to ensure the safety of all participants, all participants must follow Community Center Rules and Regulations:

- Youth ages 5 and under will not be allowed without proper supervision (Parent/Guardian) 18 Years and Older.
- Alcohol, Drugs and Tobacco Products and the use of these products are not allowed around or in the Community Center.
- Smoking is only allowed in designated areas (where ashtrays are located).
- Weapons of any sort are not allowed.
- Fighting or abusive behavior in our out of building is not allowed.
- Vulgar, sexual or lewd behavior will not be tolerated.
- Disrespecting of staff or volunteers will not be tolerated.
- Bullying, harassing, or threatening others is not allowed
- Vandalism or littering will not be tolerated.
- Animals are not allowed in the building
- Everyone is required to have a shirt and shoes on before entering the Community Center.
- Riding of Skateboards, Bikes, roller blades, heely's or scooter's is not allowed in the community center.
- Food and drinks allowed only at tables.

Violators of the rules and regulations may be denied access or entry to the community center depending on the severity or the offense.

Offenses

1st offense: 5 Minute Break/ Warning

2nd offense: 10 Minute Break/ Warning or sent home for rest of day

3rd offense: Sent home for rest of day or suspension

Suspensions

1st violation: 1 week suspension

2nd violation: 1 month suspension

3rd violation: 1 year suspension

Violations involving a crime or a particularly severe act will be a mandatory **3 months- 1 year suspension** from all recreation facilities (Tribal Gym, Skate Park, Community Center, Ball Park, and Unity Park) or any activities and field trips sponsored by the recreation department. **The Community Center Staff is not responsible for children when they leave the building unless they are on a field trip or doing a Center activity elsewhere.**
