8 FROM THE OTHER.

11 marriage or adopted by us during our marriage and spouse 2, to her  
12 knowledge, is not pregnant.

14 b.  We have signed a Child Custody Agreement which states who our children  
15 will live with, who will pay for their support, who will make the decisions  
16 regarding their education, medical treatment, dental treatment, religious  
17 training, and what visitation rights the noncustodial parent will have. A copy  
18 of our Child Custody Agreement is attached to this petition.
